PLEASE RETAIN THIS USER GUIDE FOR FUTURE PREFERENCE

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- 1) Read all instructions before using this fireplace
- 2) The fireplace is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. Keep combustible material such as furniture, cushions, bedding, paper, clothes, curtains at least 3 feet from the front of the unit
- 3) Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used near children and whenever the unit is left operating and unattended.
- 4) Do not operate a fireplace with a damaged cord or plug, or if the heater has malfunctioned, the fireplace has dropped or damaged in any manner
- 5) Not all fireplaces are suitable for use in bathrooms or laundry facilities. Please consult with individual product literature to confirm suitability.
- 6) Do not run the cord under carpeting or cover it with rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange the cord away from traffic areas and places where it could be tripped over.

UNPACKING AND TESTING APPLIANCE

Carefully remove the appliance from the box.

Prior to installing the appliance, test to make sure the appliance operates properly by plugging the power supply cord into a conveniently located 120 Volt grounded outlet. Test all aspects of its operation (manual switches, remote and heater) to make sure all components operate correctly.


As with most electronic devices, your electric fireplace has been designed to operate at temperatures between 5 $^{\circ}$ C (41 $^{\circ}$ F) and 35 $^{\circ}$ C (95 $^{\circ}$ F). During the cold winter months, allow the fireplace to reach room temperature before turning it on.

NOTE: There may be trace odor during the first few minutes of initial use. This is harmless, normal, and will never occur again.

GROUNDING APPLIANCE

This appliance is for use on 120 volts. The cord has a plug as shown in (A). An adapter as shown in (C) is available for connecting three-blade grounding type plugs to two-slot receptacles. The green grounding lug extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box. The adapter should not be used if a three-slot grounded receptacle is available.

To disconnect appliance, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.

CHOOSING A LOCATION FOR THE FIREPLACE

Plan where to place and frame the fireplace. Before installation consider the following:


- The location of the fireplace must allow for wall and ceiling clearances.
- 2. Consider a location where the fireplace screen will not be exposed to direct sunlight from windows or doors.
- A 15 ampere, 120 Volt, 60 Hz branch circuit with proper ground must be available at the location. A dedicated branch circuit should be provided to avoid circuit breakers to trip or fuses to blow.








INSTALLATION- BUILT-IN

NOTE: Due to the many different materials used to build walls, it is highly recommended that you consult your local builder before you install this appliance on a wall.


Preparation

- 1. Select a location that is not prone to moisture and is located at least 0.91m or 3 feet away from combustible materials such as curtains, drapes, furniture, bedding, paper, etc.
- 2. Mark the desired location on the floor and store the appliance in a safe, dry and dust free place.
- 3. Prepare a wall with a framed opening to accommodate the size of your unit. Leave at least 1/4" (6mm) around the edge of the appliance. Any new wiring must be done in compliance with local and national codes and other applicable regulations.

Prior to installing, test the appliance to make sure the appliance is fully operational by plugging the power supply cord into a 120 Volt grounded outlet.




NOTE: Fireplace removal should be a simple process. The reason for removal of a fireplace may vary and include changing the PCB, heater and fan.

Take note of the air intake vent located at the bottom and behind the front trim.


1. Lay down the fireplace, unscrew 2 screws at the trim bottom.




2. Pull out the trim at the bottom and then push upward to take off the trim. Remove EPE packaging material. Disconnect the wiring of the log set from the fireplace and then remove the log set.




3. Unscrew the screws to take off the left and right inner side panel.



4. Put the fireplace into the wall opening and fix it to the wall by screwing 1 screw each side.



5. Screw back the left and right inner side panel. Put back the log set, connecting the wiring of the log set to the fireplace and then put back the trim.


The fireplace comes with pre-set log set only. Consumers may purchase optional decorative media if they choose. See dealer for more details.

MEDIA INSTALLATION

1. Lay down the fireplace, unscrew 2 screws at the trim bottom.



2. Pull out the trim at the bottom and then push upward to take off the trim. Remove EPE packaging material. Disconnect the wiring of the log set from the fireplace and then remove the log set.



INSTALLING THE DECORATIVE MEDIA

Put the tray board that comes with fireplace as part into the tray. Pour the media into the tray. Feel free to use any combination of the media that you find most appealing. Put back the trim after you finish installing the media.

OPERATION

The Fireplace operates by using either the touch panel located on the upper left hand corner or by remote control.

Plug the fireplace into a 15 Amp wall socket.

MANUAL OPERATION



- 1. Press **t** to turn on and off the fireplace.
- 2. Press ♠ to adjust the flame's brightness. There are 7 brightness levels (L5 L4 L3 L2 L1 L0 L6). The indicator light turns off automatically leaving it not operated within 10 seconds.
- 3. Press

 to adjust the ember bed brightness. There are 12 brightness levels (D4 − D5 − D6 − D7 − D8 − D9 − DA − DB − D0 − D1 − D2 − D3).
- 4. Press to set the turn-off time, 30min-1h-2h-3h-4h-5h-6h-7h-8h-t0. The indicator light turns off automatically leaving it not operated within 10 seconds. The timing turns off when is pressed.
- 5. Press **W** to turn on and off the heater in its AUTO mode. The setting temperature switch through 59°F 61°F 63°F 64°F 66°F 68°F 70°F 72°F 73°F 75°F 77°F 79°F 81°F 83°F °F in Fahrenheit or 15°C -16°C -17°C 18°C 19°C 20°C 21°C 22°C 23°C 24°C 25°C 26°C 27°C 28°C °C in Celsius. The temperature setting mode will be closed automatically if leaving not operated for 5 seconds.
- 6. When the heater is on, press the *lead* for 5 seconds to switch between Celsius and Fahrenheit.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION

For remote to function make sure the fireplace is plugged in and the remote has batteries.

Important: When operating the remote make sure you point the remote to the center of the fireplace. Each time you press the button, the buzzer inside the unit will beep once. It takes some time for the receiver to respond to the transmitter. Do not PRESS the buttons more than once within two seconds for correct operation.

Set the current time of the remote control

Press the to activate the remote control and press to set the time and date. When one of the "Sun" "Mon" " Tue" "Wed" "Thu" "Fri" "Sat" is flashing, press or to set the day of the week, press to confirm day of the week and then enter hour setting. Press or to set the hour, press to confirm the hour and then enter minute setting. Press or to set the minute and press to confirm the minute and finish time setting.



- Press this Power button to turn on and off the fireplace.
- Press this Timer button to set the time to turn off the fireplace. The available settings range from 30 minutes to 8 hours. As shown in the following: 0:30 1:00 1:30 2:00 2:30 3:00 3:30 4:00 4:30 5:00 5:30 6:00 6:30 7:00 7:30 8:00. Once you have set the timer, the icon will be displayed on the LCD screen of the remote control. Press this button again to cancel the timer setting and the icon disappears.
- Press this button to turn on and off the LIT log light.



Each time the Heater Button is pressed, the power of the heater will change. As shown the following: H1- H2- AUTO (72°F or 22°C) - OFF (no display)


H1 means the firepalce on Low Heat at 700W.

H2 means the fireplace operates at 1400W.

AUTO means fireplace can automatically adjust to the temperature you set. When in AUTO, you can set the desired temperature with or keys. You can switch temperature between Celsius and Fahrenheit with or keys. When it is on Auto mode, fireplace operate at 1400W.



Press this button to adjust the speed of the flame. There are 3 options: High-Medium-Low.



Press this button to turn on and off the tray light. When in ON position, the LCD screen of the remote control show 6 3 0. Press or of or b to change the brightness of each tray color.

Press this button to turn on and off the flame light. When in ON position, the LCD screen of the remote control show 6 2. Press or to change the brightness of each flame color.

Tray
There are preset color combinations of flame and tray light, press "Flame" or "Tray"
to choose your desired flame light or tray light color combination.



Press once, 7 days from Monday to Sunday will display on the LCD screen of the remote control, press within 5 seconds to enter 7 day timer function. When "Sun" flashes, press or to select the day that you want to set, press to confirm your setting. Then "ON" will be display on the LCD screen of the remote control, at the same time, digital of time hour flashes, press or to set the time to turn the fireplace on. After setting the startup time, "OFF" will be displayed on the LCD screen and press or to set the shutdown time. When the shutdown time's set, "AUTO" will be displayed on the LCD screen of the remote control and the digital of temperature flashes. At this time, you can set the temperature by or vow Now, you have finished setting of this function.

When the 7 day timer's set, the icon will be displayed on the LCD screen of the remote control. Press again to cancel the 7 day timer and the icon will disappears.

NOTE: If the 7 day timing and the general timing are set at the same time, the system will respond to an earlier shutdown time.

Press Refer button to check the settings of 7 day timer. Press or to see the settings of the day of the week and or the settings of the startup and shutdown time.

INSTALL TuyaSmart life

WIFI SETTING AND FIREPLACE OPERATION

NOTE: Make sure the Bluetooth of your phone is turned on during the following steps.

- 1. Create an account and log in.
- 2. When you log in, touch "+" (FIG.1) to enter in FIG.2. Touch "Small Home appliances" on the left side and then choose "Electric Fireplace (BLE+Wi-Fi)" to enter in FIG.3 to reset the device.






FIG.5 FIG.6 FIG.7

- 3. Press the flame button until the timer button flashes(FIG.4). Then confirm to go next to set your Wi-Fi account and password (FIG.5). Please make sure the Wi-Fi account and password you set are correct and Wi-Fi signal is good.
- 4. The APP will search and recommend the devices automatically (FIG.6) for you to add to.
- 5. Touch "Done" to finish Wi-Fi setting. (FIG.7)







It is extended only to the original purchaser and is non-transferable. Proof of purchase from an authorized supplier is required.

WARRANTY COVERAGE AND TERM

Products covered under this warranty have been factory-tested and inspected prior to shipment. Amantii warrants that these products are free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service for one (1) year from the date of original purchase.

Where applicable, any implied warranties are also limited to one (1) year, unless restricted by local law. ADDITIONAL WARRANTY CONDITIONS

Proper Installation & Operation:

This electric fireplace must be installed and operated in full compliance with the installation and operating instructions provided. Any unauthorized repair, modification, misuse, accident, or abuse will immediately void the warranty.

Original Owner Only:

This warranty applies only to the original owner, provided the product was purchased through an authorized Amantii dealer.

Defect Confirmation:

Warranty coverage is limited to repair or replacement of parts confirmed to be defective in material or workmanship after inspection by Amantii. Defective parts must have been subject to normal use and conditions.
